What to expect from the initial evaluation:

Your child's first visit to Pediatric Therapy will last approximately one hour for each therapy provided. During this time, we will get to know you and your child, as well as learn about his or her specific needs. The therapist will complete a formal evaluation and prepare a treatment plan with you.

How to schedule the initial evaluation:

In order to schedule a physical, occupational and/or speech-language evaluation, you must first obtain a prescription for each therapy from your child's physician. Then call our department at (810) 216-1800. Please have your insurance information available when you make the call. Your child will be scheduled for an evaluation at the first available appointment time.
